

Woodland Valley Farm Profile

Woodland Valley farm is 170 acres in total, with 20 acres of woodland, 6 acres of new nut orchard and 144 acres of farmland. It is right in the centre of Cornwall in the far south west.

Woodland Valley has been farmed by the Jones Family since 1960. Chris Jones took over daily running of the farm in 1990 with his wife Janet. They have 3 children, Felicity, 12, William, 11, and Jackie, 7.



Woodland Valley is an organic farm, where no artificial fertilisers or other inputs are used. The main activities here are a small beef suckler herd,



a breeding herd of rare pigs, and a study centre where schools can stay on the farm and learn about the countryside. This is a big part of our work from April through to September.



We keep some chickens and ducks for eggs for the family and visitors, and we sell our meat at a local market twice a month.



We also harvest apples to turn into cider.
